IKF Level III. “Youth Coach Camp”

Recognition: “Apprentice coach” diploma.

Dates: 16th to 22nd August 2015.

Where: Dordrecht.

IKF Level III “Youth Coach Camp”.

After developing new educational program we identified the need to educate young coaches in order to provide them with best tools and knowledge to train the youngest teams, to introduce accurately new training concepts and to develop new playing formats like K4/Beach Korfball.

According to the **IOC / ARISF Development program**, IKF is entitled to run a course every year according to IOC goals in order to spread the korfball knowledge through the different continents. After different training camps were held in 2012’s IKF Level II Delhi (India), 2013’s World Games Clinics in Cali (Colombia) and 2014’s IKF AAKC Clinics in Lusaka (Zambia), now is time for the IKF Level III “Youth Coach Camp” to be run in Europe.

The scope of this course will be defined according to Ben Crum’s “*The IKF Guide to korfball coaching*” , implemented by the best coaches for youth education and including several generic subjects to all team sports.

Program and Target group of applicants:

This course is addressed to coaches with following background:

- Head coaches of U17/U15/U13 national teams,
- Technical directors of the national organizations,
- Coaches conducting training programs for youth academies.

In order to learn about the skills required to conduct korfball teams at different levels, and to be able to design and deliver content for youth teams at their home country, the participation in the course need to be requested by the national organization (see more details in the “**Enrolment sheet**”).

Coaches need to be fluent in english and prove their coaching experience through their national organization according to the requirements of the course.

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The program will contain a total amount of 60 hours divided in 2 different stages:

- A. **“IKF III Course Youth Coaches Camp”**. The training program will be delivered in central meeting to be held during week 16th to 22nd August in Dordrecht. This block contains 45 hours of lectures.

- B. **“Generic Subjects tests”**. To obtain final certificate every aspirant must pass tests included in the section for IKF Level II Course. Generic Subjects tests. This section is part of the educational program shared in all team sports and *Specific subjects* about the coaching of korfball contained in the course. With 15 hours of online lectures.

How we train you? The Youth Coach Camp 2015.

The program of the course will be running during the period from 16th to 22nd August 2015. in Dordrecht. During this period a group of 20 coaches will be joining the experience of a training camp and will follow education with the best coaches, by performing during trainings, theoretical sessions and matches adjusting to the reality of different groups of players, ages and levels.

How to participate? Enrolment process.

Candidates eligible to enroll have to apply before **15th June 2015** by sending the official application considering following details:

- Certification of the national organization of the coach experience as coach for U17/U15/U13 national teams; as Technical director of the national organization; as Coach conducting training programs for youth academies.
- A passport photo and a copy of ID/passport.
- Fill in the personal information at the “Enrolment sheet”.
- Application letters to attend the course should be sent to office@ikf.org
- National organizations participating in the *TOP 6 Program* are expected to appoint at least a number of 2 coaches according to conditions mentioned.
- After application has been approved participants will be requested to pay **entrance Fee of 100 €**.

Application to **IKF Level III. Youth Coach Camp** is free by sending data required and/or motivational letter. After application is accepted and entry fee is paid, the course will provide all costs related with lodging and meals during the period 16th to 22nd August . Applications will be accepted according to following conditions:

- A total number of 20 applications will be accepted.
- A maximum number of 10 places will be offered to countries participating in the TOP 6 Program.
- A maximum number of 10 places will be offered for the rest of the countries according to following points:
 - 1st. IKF ranking (therefore C countries will have priority to appoint their coaches, then D countries, etc.)
 - 2nd. Maximum 1 application per country.
 - 3rd. At least 4 places will be guaranteed for applications received from countries outside Europe (at least 1 place per continent will be reserved) .
- The applications received from outside Europe can request for Scholarship according to the following conditions:
 - Africa*: 400 € for travel costs + 50 € entrance fee.
 - America*: 400 € for travel costs + 50 € entrance fee.
 - Asia*: 400 € for travel costs + 50 € entrance fee.
 - Oceania*: 400 € for travel costs + 50 € entrance fee.

*when travelling from outside Europe.
